



The South Fox Ranch is nothing more than solitary ranch house on a hill overlooking the prairie to the south, a horse pasture to the west and farmland to north and east, it is located in southern part of the Lucky Mound segment of the Three Affiliated Tribes in North Dakota. It was named after the original owner E.M. Fox

At her passing in 2012 it was left to her two youngest sons. In 2014, the brothers decided to start contributing to charitable organizations and Native sporting events under the South Fox Ranch as way to honor their mother for all the sacrifices and hardships she endured raising her family as a single parent.

Sadly in 2019, one of the brothers passed. Today with the assistance of his nieces and other family members the sole surviving brother continues on with the South Fox Ranch in contributing to charitable organizations and Native sporting events in memory of their mother and grandmother E.M. Fox.
